


#### Dear Wallaroo Families,

To improve communication between the school and our families, we are switching to Compass School Manager as our Parent Portal. Please note that from the start of Term 2 we will no longer be using the Sentral Parent Portal and Compass will become our primary communication platform.

Using the Compass Parent Portal you will be able to:

- -Access your child's Student Progress and Semester Reports
- -Book your Parent/Student/Teacher conferences
- -View up-to-date school attendance information
- -Approve or enter upcoming or past absences for your son/daughter
- -Pay for, download, print and approve upcoming excursions (coming soon)
- -Pay for school fees and contributions (coming soon)
- -Update your registered email and mobile number (used for SMS alerts) details
- -Access information regarding upcoming events and news
- -Accessing Compass



Next week you will receive your login details for Compass, we will be sending these out via email and hardcopy. Please ensure you log into Compass before the holidays so that you can reach out if you need and assistance.

Each and every day our students display positive behaviours for learning! This week we celebrate...


### Prep/1E




### Year 1/2 CA




### Year 4/5R

### **FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE INFORMATION FOR PARENTS**

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities. It is part of making Victoria the Education State and the Government's commitment to breaking the link between a student's background and their outcomes.

## CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors. Excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works while sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are a part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- \$125 for primary school students
- \$225 for secondary school students

#### **HOW TO APPLY**

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from the website below.

If you applied for CSEF at your child's school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- ⇒ **new student enrolments**; your child has started or changed schools this year.
- changed family circumstances; such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing this year.

Check with the school office if you are unsure.
